

GAME DAY EXPECTATIONS:

- 10U-12U 4 parents from each team of first game arrive 60 minutes early to set up goals (must be up and ready 30 minutes prior to game time). Disposable gloves and wipes available at monitor tents
- 6U first game (coach team) put up pugs w/pegs, last game (coach team) takes it down and puts it back in closet at comfort station.
- 8U-12U Arrive at the field 30 minutes prior to game. 6U arrive 5 minutes prior to training time
- Spectators watch from cars. If windows down, masks must be on
- 10U/12U Linesperson to pick up flag at monitor tent and report to field w/cloth mask
- Meet coach team at designated meeting spot; players warm up, parents park and remain in car
- Coach team to take role, 10U/12U include linesperson, and email weekly to r100cvpa@aysohawaii.org
- Games will not start if there are spectators in unpermitted locations
- One team captain per team will meet the referee for coin toss before game
- 10U/12U Linespeople to return flag to monitor tent and wipe with cleaning wipe
- Players, coach teams, referees and field staff all to wear cloth masks to cover mouth and nose the entire time they are on the field
- Players place their bags with all belongings 6 feet apart on sideline
- Coach team to hold/mark game card w/referee check at each quarter, goal or as needed
- Once the game is pau, 1 parent meet child and go directly to the car. There will be no handshake or cheers at the end of the game this year. Players collect their bag and meet family.
- Coach team puts game card in bin at field tent
- 10U-12U 4 parents from each team of last game tear down goals and put them in the closet at the comfort station. Disposable gloves and wipes available at monitor tents

BATHROOM BREAKS: 6U-10U Coach team will text the adult to meet them at the drop off location, take player to bathroom, return player to coach team member so they can return to the game and adult returns to car. Cloth masks must be worn at all times. 12U coach team can send 3 players to the bathroom or text adult to meet them.
